



NLP Practitioner Certification Syllabus

The duration of the NLP Practitioner Certification training is to be carried out over a minimum of 80 hours of which 49 must be completed over a minimum of 7 days face-to-face training and the additional hours can be made up by pre-course, in-course and post-course study in the basic skills of NLP patterns led by a Certified Trainer of NLP from a recognised trainer. Where post-course study is part of the course, Certification cannot be awarded until all post-course study is complete.
